Intentional Large-Scale Paper Piecing — Magic Spark

April 16, 2020: 9:30 am - 3:30 pm

Magic Spark serves as a great introduction to modern, large scale paper piecing. Paper piecing with larger pieces of fabric is in many ways more difficult than paper piecing with small pieces that are more easily handled. Learn some new tricks to make large scale paper piecing work while also learning to place your fabric intentionally to enhance the pattern design. Explore various layouts for a unique quilt top.

Modern Selvage Quilts –Selvage Whirlwind

April 17, 2020: 12:30 - 3:30 pm

Have you been saving those precious selvages for ages but aren't quite sure what to do with them? Selvage Whirlwind is a fun modern quilt that makes use of a wide range of colored selvages from your collection. Learn how best to collect selvages, what makes a selvage design work, and create several selvage blocks sharing selvages with your classmates so you have a wide range of colors.

Hawaiian Inspired Appliqué

May 7, 2020: 9:30 am - 3:30 pm

Learn how to make the Big Island Blossom block. This quilt is a modern interpretation of traditional Hawaiian quilts. Students will learn how to prepare the appliqué (including folding, cutting and basting) and how to apply the motif using needle-turn appliqué techniques. Class includes a brief introduction to traditional Hawaiian quilts, best practices, step-by-step instructions and quilting tips. Sewing machines are not required for this workshop. This is a fun, relaxing slow-stitching workshop.

Dragonfly Dance

May 8, 2020: 12:30 - 3:30 pm

Learn how to make the Dragonfly Dance mini quilt. The design incorporates the repeat of foundation paper pieced blocks. Some previous foundation paper piecing experience is helpful, but not required. The class is geared towards quilters who want more experience with foundation paper piecing. Class includes paper piecing best practices, step-by-step instructions, lots of tricks and quilting tips.

To be eligible for this challenge, the quilt must:

- have been started after the announcement of the challenge
- have a perimeter of less than 144 inches
- be finished (quilted and bound)
- have no uncovered identifying labels
