### 1. HOW DOES IT WORK?

Choose unfinished projects that have already been cut or partially sewn and finish 'em up!

This means a finish, with a binding or facing or however you would artistically finish it off.

### 2. WHAT QUALIFIES?

- i. A UFO that you have not touched in over a year since beginning of April 2022. The older the better!
- ii. Any size
- iii. Enter as many as you like and will receive a chance for each entry.
- iv. Completed Entries must be brought to the June meeting or brought to Lorraine Doyno Evans to bring to the June meeting.
- v. Projects and fabric sitting around waiting to be started do NOT count as UFOs
- vi. You must send a picture of its current UFO status to Lorraine Doyno Evans with a few background words of this project to participate.

### 3. YOUR REWARD

- i. You will have sense of accomplishment of finishing something you started long ago
- ii. You will have more room for stash and projects
- iii. You will be entered to win a **non-transferrable** half day workshop or equivalent for the **2022-2023 season!**
