Q.U.I.L.T., Inc. meets on the second Friday of every month from September-June. Doors open at 9:15AM. The meeting starts at 9:45 and ends at noon. Visitors are welcome to attend for a small donation.

MEETING FORMAT:

Members come early to greet fellow quilters, browse the library, scan the information tables, and shop the mini-mart. A brief business meeting begins at 9:45 followed by a lecture and trunk show by a guest speaker, or scheduled celebrations. One of the highlights of the monthly meetings is “Show and Share” when members are encouraged to share their latest projects with the group.

All-day or afternoon workshops are scheduled in advance for the year. Other activities include service projects, open sew, and informal sewing groups.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to anyone interested in quilting. Payment of annual dues entitles members to voting privileges, newsletter subscription, use of the library, access to workshops, discounts at some fabric stores, and special privileges when they arise. Members are encouraged to join a number of active committees such as service, fundraisers, newsletter, and Quilt Show.
